As we prepare for the official launch of our **Building Project** we are forming two main project groups, this will be following Monday's PCC meeting. Data held by St. Peter's Church will not be shared with any third party organisations without your prior permission/knowledge. Our overarching assurance is that your personal information is securely and safely held, whether electronically or in hardcopy.

Thank you to those who have joined our **planned giving scheme**, in the last few months. Your financial support is greatly appreciated. St. Peter's is completely self-funding with no external help whatsoever from the Church of England. Whilst our costs are currently balanced by income (*we thank God for that*) we are looking at substantial increases in costs in 2019 as grants for two of our staff (family worker and worship leader) will come to an end and at the same time our parish share will be increasing by 23%. We are therefore, inviting those who are not currently part of our planned giving scheme to consider making a monthly contribution to the funding of this church. On Wednesday 18th July, Tim will be baptising several members of St. Peter's Church by full immersion. We have hired St. John's Egham for the evening as they have a baptismal 'pool'.
