Funding Ministry at St. Peter's – At our recent finance meeting, we looked carefully at figures for the first part of 2018. Whilst a number of people have joined our planned giving scheme during the last few months, we are seeking to increase our monthly giving by approximately £1,200 each month to ensure our finances are secure. St. Peter's is entirely self-funding with no support from the wider Church of England. We run a 'tight and efficient ship' with careful cost controls and yet our expenditure for this year is approaching £200,000. *At the end of this year the existing funding for Annie Burnham (Families Worker) and Matt Osgood (Worship Coordinator) comes to an end. We intend to retain Annie on a part-time permanent basis and Matt for an additional 18 months, (after the current funding runs out), until the end of Eils' curacy.*

If you are not yet part of our Planned Giving Scheme, we would invite you to consider supporting St. Peter's through our monthly planned giving scheme. We are able to accept both one off and regular donations by online bank transfer.
